Ginny: No I would not like to have one because things don't stay in that well anyway. And if you had a zipper then some of them could come out on you.

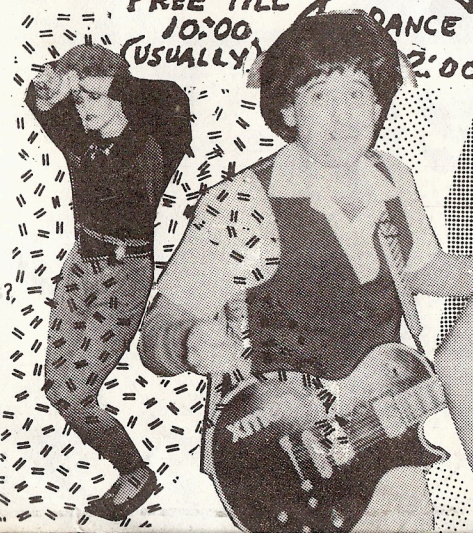
