

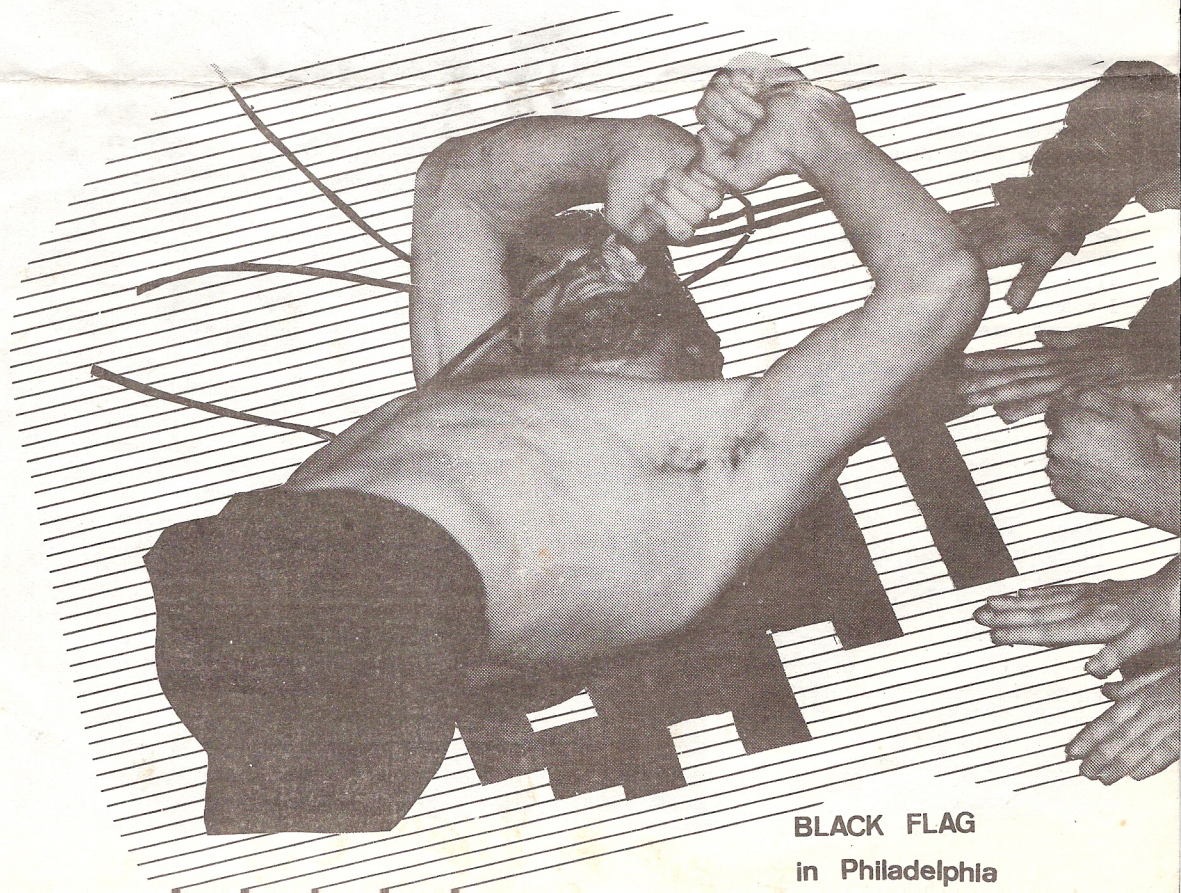

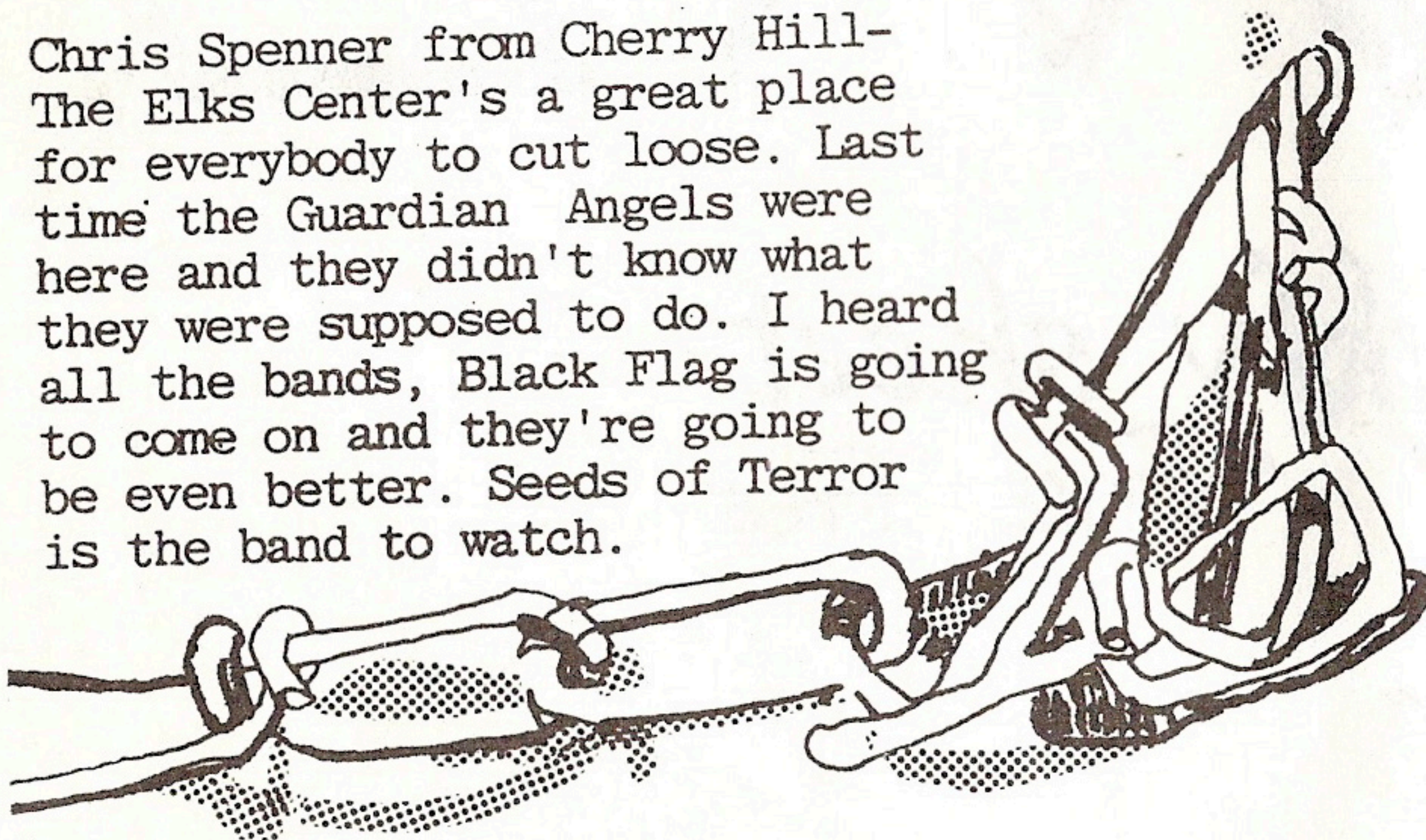

Mikey Wilde- I think Black Flag is a great band. I'm going to L.A. in June. I think they're great.

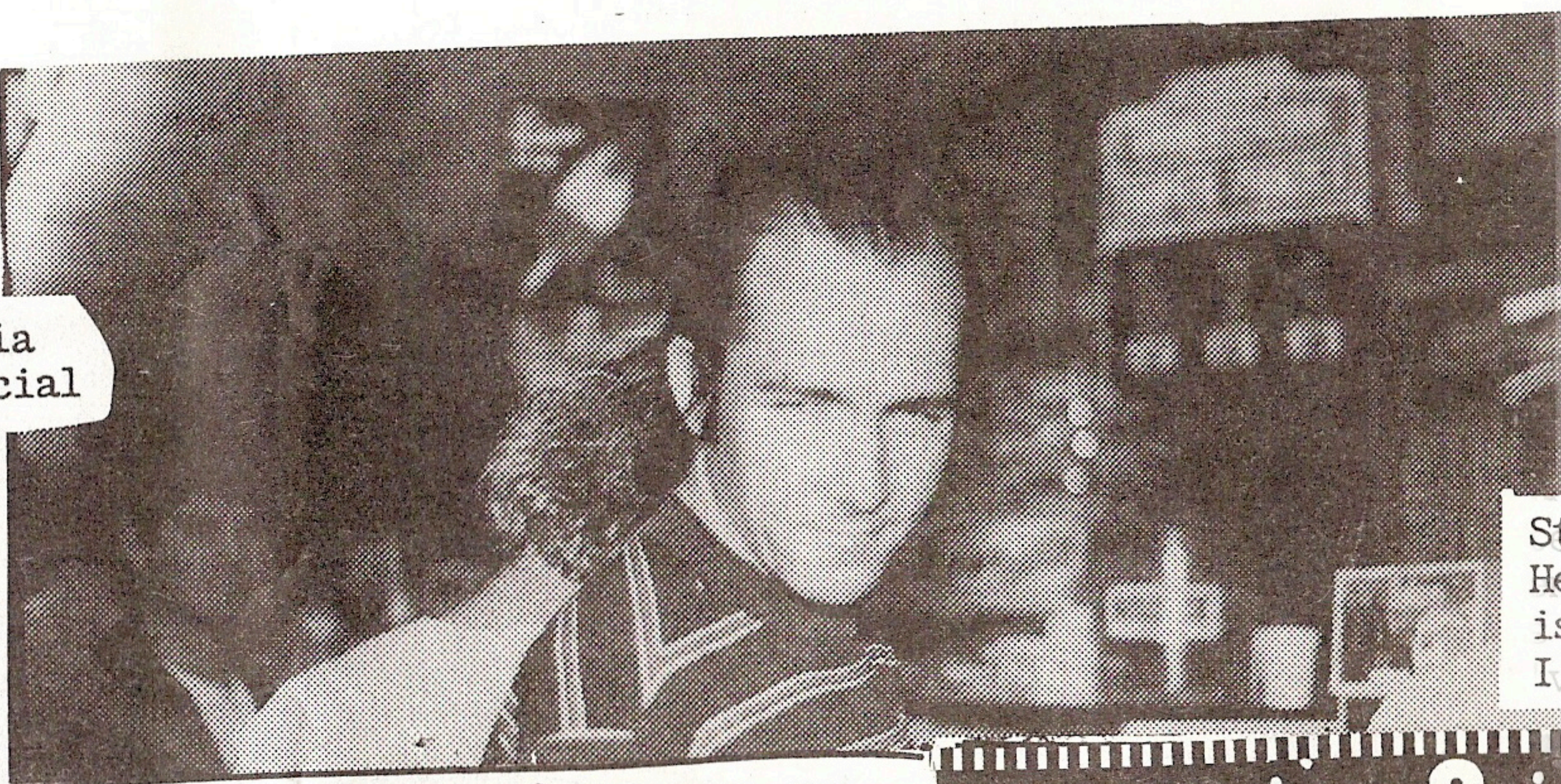
John Koo- The Elks Center is a hip place but Black Flag, they look different. I don't know if they have as much energy as before.

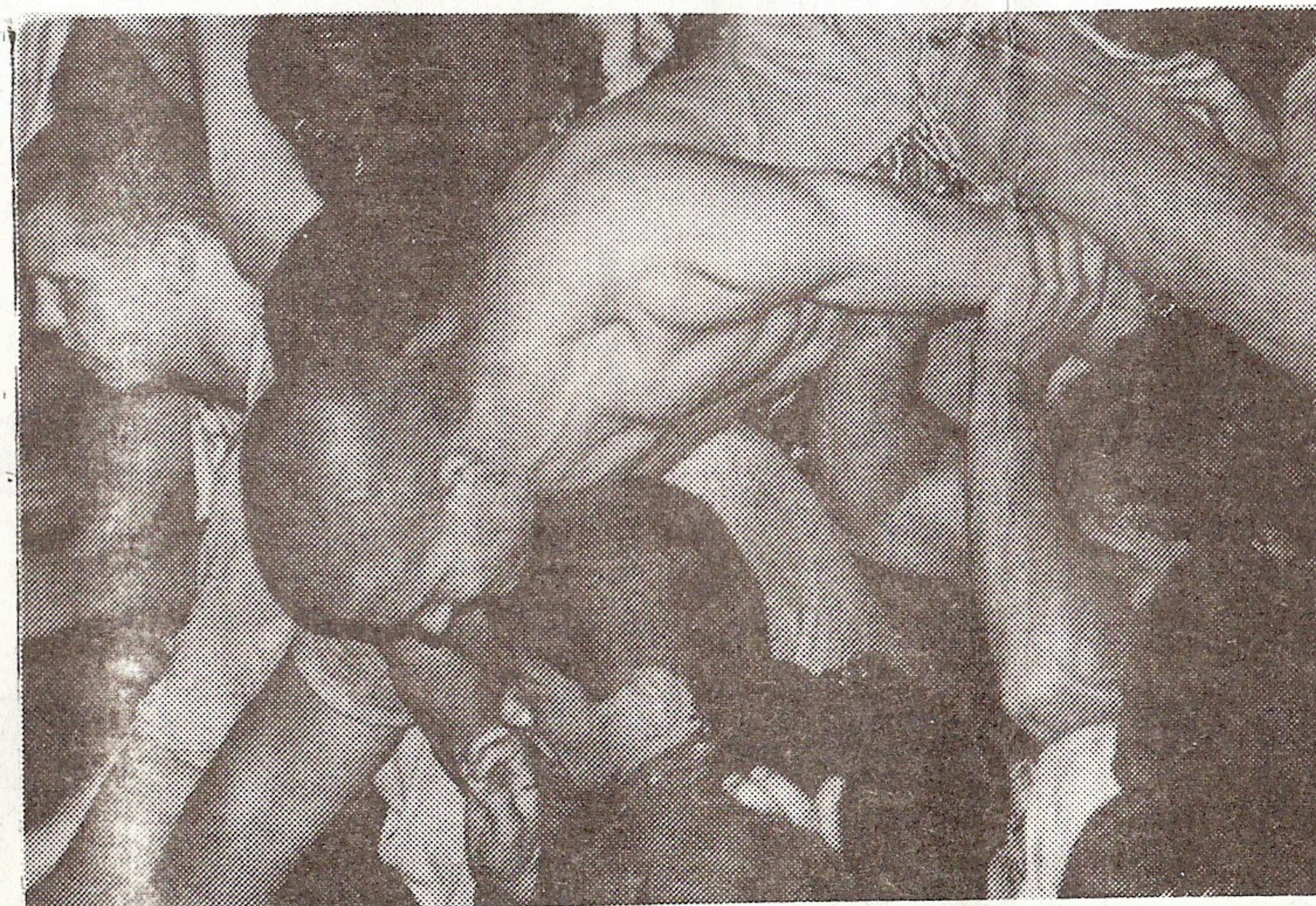
Bill (Third Street Jazz)- I never saw so much scum in my life. This is great.

# Actress Romy Schneider at 43, in friend's apartment in Paris

Interview with Chuck and Henry, bass  
player and vocalist from Black Flag.

Chuck:  
People's expectations may be slightly different. It's an emotional thing we're communicating, emotional and physical.  
Elaine: What possesses you to travel around the country the way you do in vans?  
Chuck: I like to do it and it matters to me. I want to have an impact on people. maybe it'll knock things around a little bit.

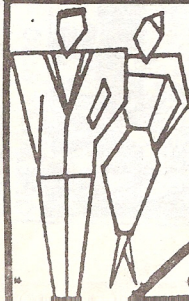
Henry: I have this stuff in my head and in my heart and I want to get it out. I want to inflict myself on as many people as possible. There are things I want to get across.

Steve: To alot of people Black Flag epitomizes the hard core band in America, for some reason you've captured that element, after seeing you tonight I really don't understand why. Do you have any ideas on that?

Chuck: I'm blind, I can't see past your eyes, you can't see past mine. I don't understand what makes you work.

Steve: Why has Black Flag captured people this way?

Chuck: Our ass is on the line. We did it the way we feel. Because of that I suppose there's some urgency in it. There is to me. It's anything that's ever mattered to me put on the line.
