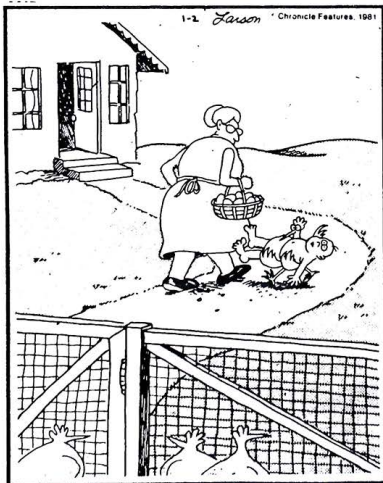
invited to play the next "round-up" type of show, with all of the major Southern red-neck rock bands.

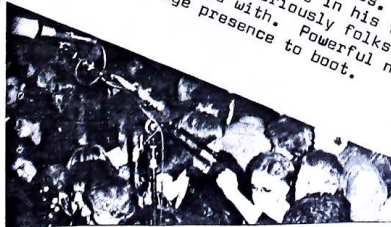

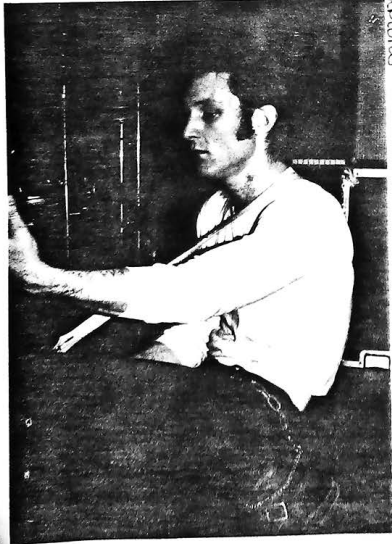

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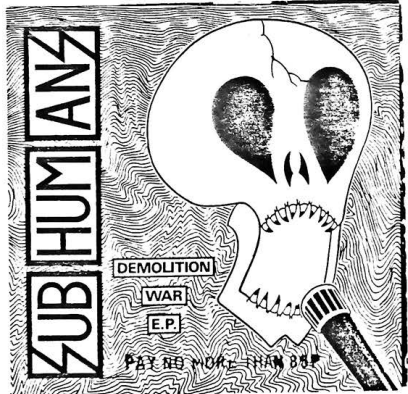


THE EXPLOITED/ANTI-FASTI: Don't Let Them Grind You Down E.P. (The Exploited Record Company)

INFA*RIOT: Kids of the 80's/Still Out Of Order (Secret Records)
music/lyrics--I wish they had given a lyric sheet with the single the lyrics I can interpret are good, the music is also very good, catchy guitar work. sleeve-- ★★★ final statistics--buy it

PETER AND THE TEST TUBE BABIES: Banned From the Fubs--Hopped Lads/Peach Haven Wild Kids (No Future Records)

music/lyrics--hit home right away, really good but not great. sleeve-- ★★★ final stats--buy it, good as an alternative hardcore band (?????)

A COUNTRY FIT FOR HEROES COMPILATION:

No Future Records 12"

This is a collection of songs taken from the demo tapes sent to No Future. What the label is attempting to do is give some unknown bands exposure by putting out a cheap 12". The one band that really stands out for me is the VIOLATORS, who have a really good female vocalist and manage to be hardcore without so much hard. Also really great is ATTACK with "Blue Patrol". There's 11 bands here--one track each except for the Violators, who get two. It takes a listen or two to get through the basically dull production on most of the tracks, but it's well worth the extra effort. The only drawback is that (I guess) due to low budget, there's no info other than band names and track titles.
